#### Who are we?

- COC Amsterdam is a volunteer organization structured as a local member association
- At this moment 170 volunteers are active, and we count around 1800 members
- Together with 19 other local associations in the Netherlands, we make up the Federation COC Netherlands
- COC Amsterdam organizes
  - meet-up & empowerment for several groups in the LGBT community
  - information and education in schools and work-settings
  - community and member events, debates and discussions
- We work with an internal code of conduct, a set of 'rules' for interaction. For some activities we ask a formal Certificate of Conduct for Natural Persons (VOG)

#### Information & Education

### Classroom presentations about homosexuality in Dutch schools

- ⇒ Schools in The Netherlands are obliged to cover the subject of homosexuality in their education
- ⇒ The presentations are led by lesbians, gays, bisexuals or transgenders, and give students the chance to confront their stereotypes.
- ⇒ Over 50 volunteers of COC Amsterdam organize around 600 presentations a year.



#### Care & Well-being

#### In general:

- ⇒ Promoting LGBT sensitive services and care, with a special focus on underserved and vulnerable LGBT (eg. Mokum Roze)
- ⇒ Providing information and advice (to best of our ability) to help LGBT in finding answers to their questions (pilot: Consultteam; Pink Card)
- ⇒ Seeking cooperation with LGBT and straight people (individuals, organizations and networks) to improve access to LGBT friendly and sensitive care & well-being
